- develop friendships and create pathways of opportunities.

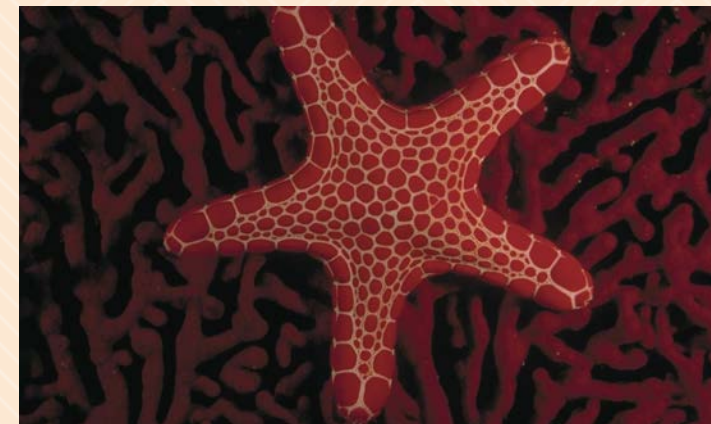
Course Overview
